


Layers Tutorial 2 - Blended Animal



Overview: You are creating an image combining multiple images to make a new animal NEVER seen before! First, you will create one following the Tutorial, and then you will create your own new animal never seen before on planet earth!


Tutorial 6 - Layers

1. Go to Online Classroom and **download** the Images - **Layers Tutorial - Image 1 and LayersTutorial - Image 2**
2. Save them BOTH into your **Student folder**.
3. **Open** the Images in Photoshop.
4. Save LayersTutorial - Image 1 (the Lizard) as **LastName_Tutorial2.psd**.
5. Go to Image 2 - (the Image of the Eagle).
6. Selecting the eagle's head is easy, because there is a strong contrast with the dark background.
7. The **Magnetic Lasso** is the best tool for this. 
8. Click and drag around the eagle's head. Be sure to **click** whenever you need to turn. It is a good idea to click each time you go in and out of a feather.
9. You only want to select the head – not any of the body



10. **Edit>Copy**
11. Go back to your **LastName_LayersTutorial.psd** the image of the lizard.
12. **Edit>Paste** the eagle head into the lizard photo.
13. **Resize and position** as needed.

- a. **Experiment** with the blending mode to change the way the head layer interacts with the background. **Hard Light** can let some of the scaliness of the lizard show through.
- b. You may need to **move** the head around to line up the **eyes**.
- c. This may cause you to need to **Clone Stamp** out some of the **lizard** that ends up showing up.



14. Switch to the **background** layer
 - a. Change the **Opacity** of the **Clone Stamp** to **50%** in order to blend the multi-colored background more effectively.
 - b. Add the text **Eaglizz** and then add the sentence: **A Mascot in search of a team?**
 - c. Add **layer styles** to each of the text layers.

15. **Ctrl + S** to save the psd.
16. Save as: **LastName_Tutorial2.jpg**
17. **Turn In**
